The steadfast lads head up to **Queensland on Thursday, 11 March** to play the **Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre** and then make their way down to **Melbourne on Saturday, 13 March** to burst the seams of The **PalaisTheatre**.

Next stop, **Adelaide** where the band will headline the **Clipsal 500 After Race Concert on Sunday, 14 March**. Status Quo will finish up the tour **Wednesday, 17 March** at the **Challenge Stadium in Perth**. Tickets for all shows go on Sale on Tuesday 27th October through the usual outlets.

In their extraordinary career Status Quo have collected masses of awards and accolades, including the converted Silver Clef Award, a Brit Award and World Music Award for their invaluable contribution to the Music Industry.

The band has also raised millions of dollars for children's charities through their epic Rock 'Til You Drop event, and was the world famous opening act for Live Aid and Wembley Stadium. Their performance had 1.5 billion viewers around the world glued to their sets and the event remains the most watched television special in history. This December mark Status Quo's unbelievable 43rd appearance at Wembley stadium.

The long-haired rock legends reunite with their Australian fans off the back of this year's Glastonbury Festival, playing to a 80,000 strong crowd, with a set including their powerful rock anthems **Whatever You Want** and **Rockin' All Over the World**.

Legions of Quo fans can start breaking out the Dunlops and tuning their air guitars – the original masters of Rock n' Roll are heading our way..and showing the youth of today how to do it right.
